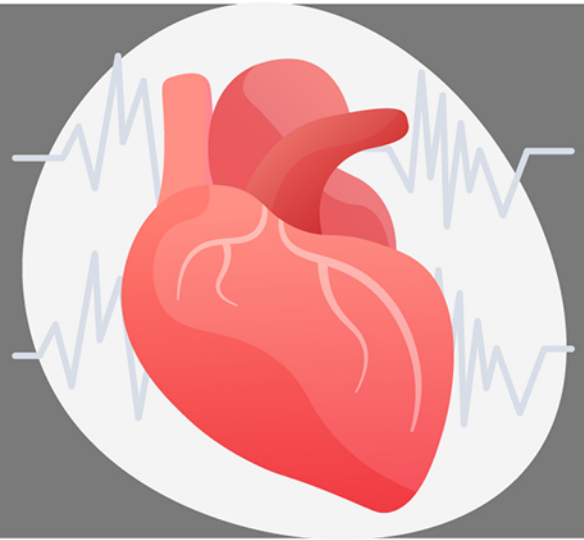


# HEART FAILURE

**SYMPTOMS** are:



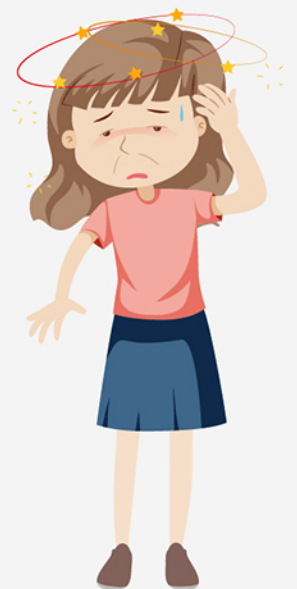
Fatigue
