A **heart attack**, also called a **myocardial infarction**, happens when **a part of the heart muscle doesn't get enough blood**.

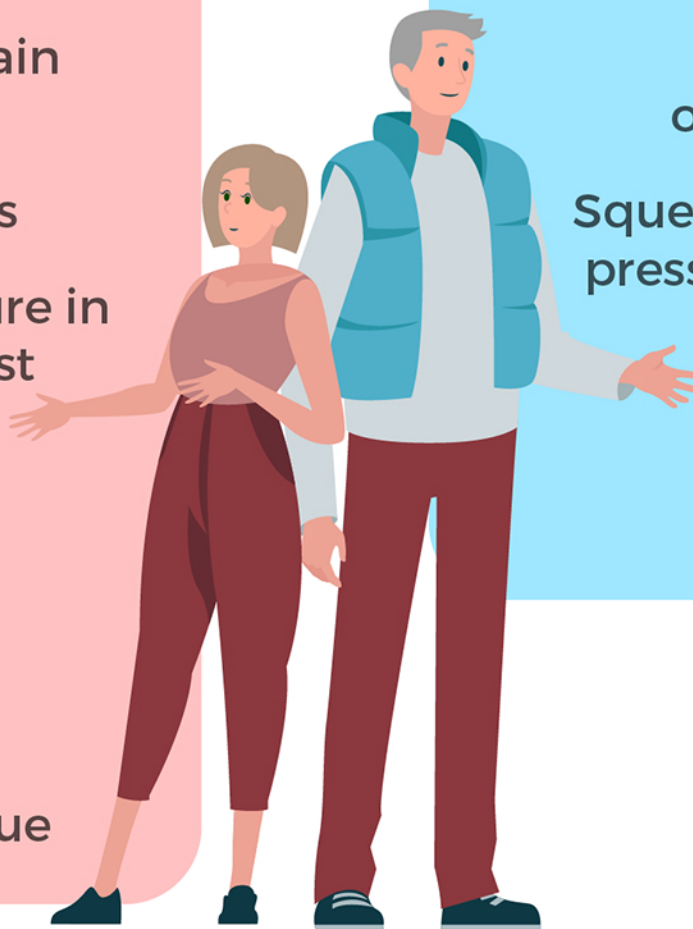
THE SYMPTOMS ARE:

WOMEN

Dizziness
Nausea or vomiting
Jaw, neck or upper back pain
Chest pain but not always
Pain or pressure in the lower chest or upper abdomen
Shortness of breath
Indigestion
Extreme fatigue

MEN

Nausea or vomiting
Jaw, neck or back pain
Squeezing chest pressure or pain
Shortness of breath
Sweating
