Diagnosis

People may have symptoms of heart failure for many years before receiving a diagnosis, and management is often suboptimal.

79% of people are diagnosed in hospital following a rapid deterioration in their symptoms requiring emergency admission.

60% of people who have been diagnosed with HF in hospital, visited their Doctor in the previous 6 month, with at least 1 major symptom of HF.
